

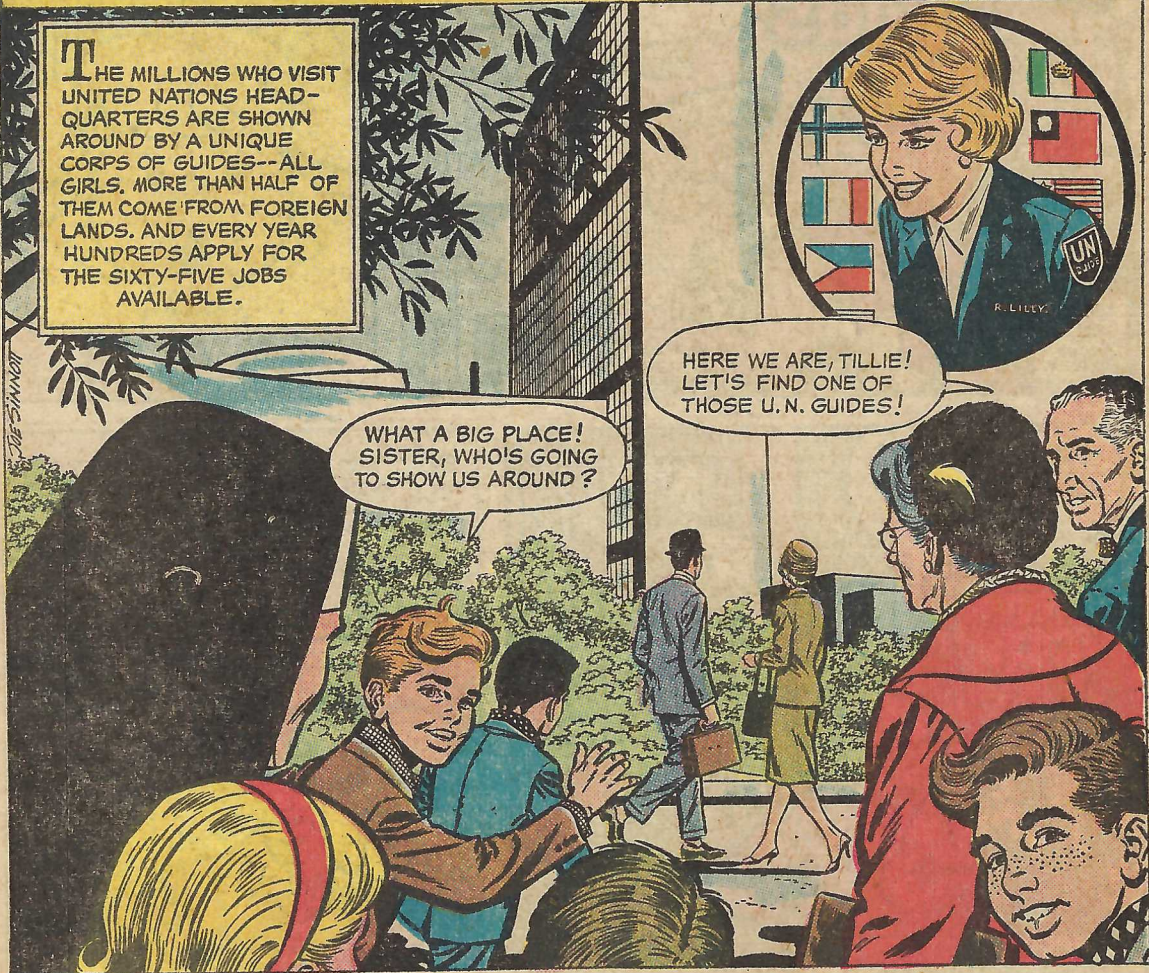
# GIRL GUIDES OF THE U.N.

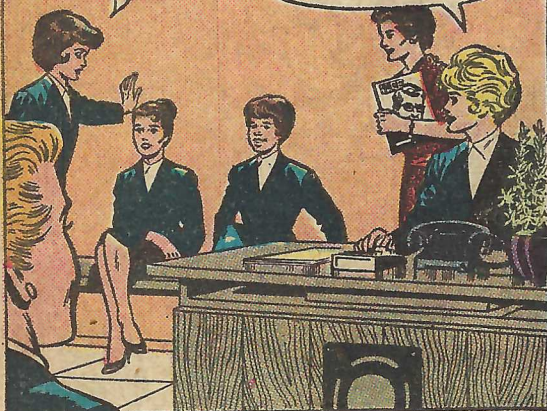

GUIDES FROM SOME COUNTRIES, SUCH AS INDIA AND JAPAN, MAY WEAR THEIR NATIVE DRESSES.



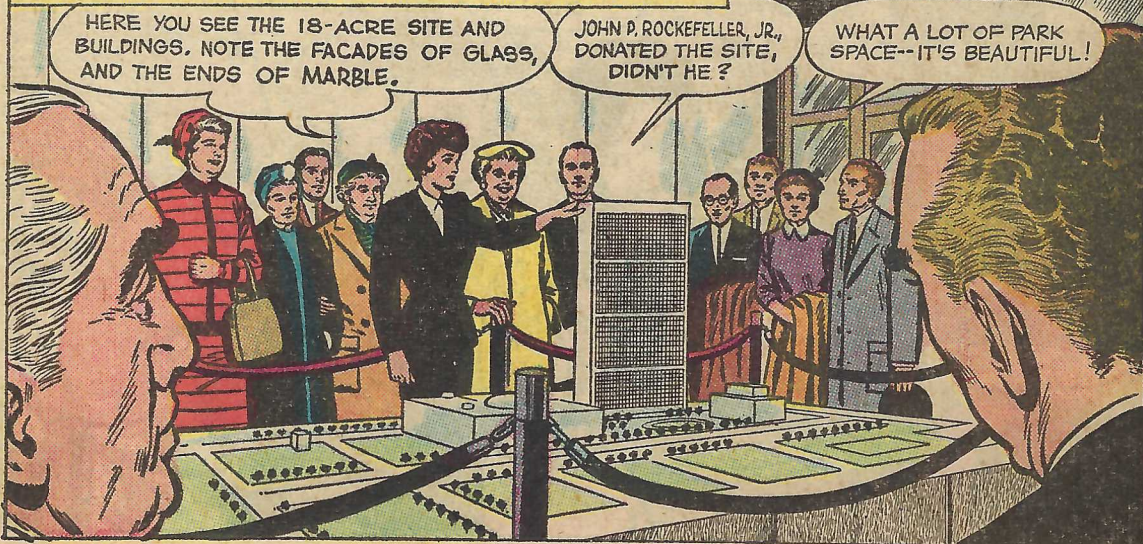

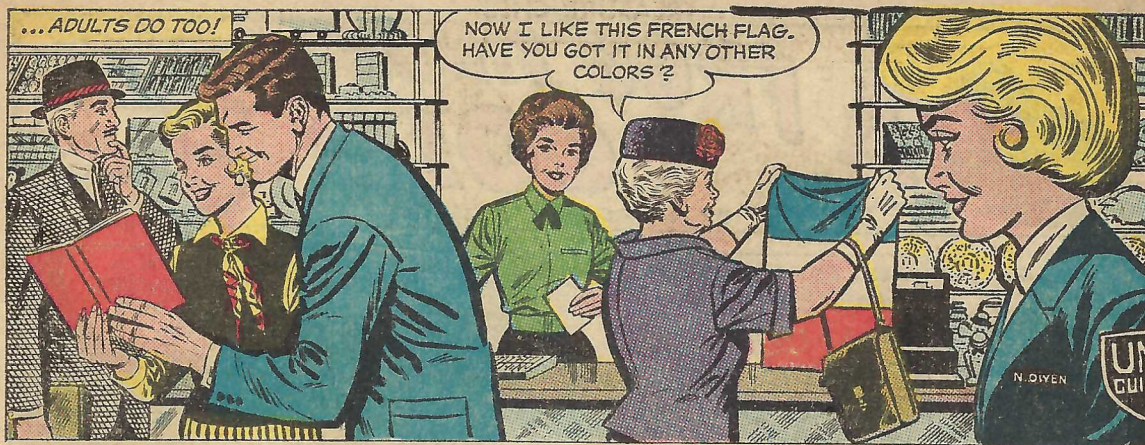


ACTUAL TOURS START AT A SCALE MODEL OF THE U.N. BUILDINGS.
